

October 2023 Board Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: The October 5th Board Meeting was called to order at 7:00PM by Mr. Leep.

Roll Call: Glenn Leep of Martin, Tom Rook of Orangeville, and Roger VanVolkinburg of Wayland were present. Rob Heethuis of Yankee Springs was absent with notice. Employees present: Director Larry Knowles and Office Manager Tara Palandri.

Review Minutes: Mr. VanVolkinburg motioned to accept the September Board Meeting minutes and Mr. Rook supported; the motion passed 3-0.

Hear Those Present: None present.

New Business:

- a. No sewer or water permits were issued in September.
- b. September Roundtable Minutes were shared with the Board.

Director's Report:

- Employees
 - Todd Kline resigned on Wednesday, October 4th. Mr. Knowles explained the rationale behind his resignation and also informed the Board of the current course of action. The duties of the position have been delegated to a few employees to keep things running smoothly while steps are taken to fill the position.

• Laboratory Technician

- The September Lab Report was reviewed.
- YST Water
 - The MOR and reports were sent to EGLE.
 - The September Water Report was reviewed.
- Miss Dig
 - 55 Miss Digs were completed in September.
- Water Laboratory
 - 298 samples were tested in September.
- Sludge Removal
 - Bob Reurink has removed the sludge- there was twice as much as anticipated.
 - The entrance gate was damaged, GLASA held \$5,000 to cover the repair costs. The estimate came in at \$3,187.00.
- Collection System Generators
 - The generator at LS #20 (Valley Dr) was installed and it is online.
 - The generator at LS #23 (Willow St) was placed and is not online as of yet.

- The last generator for this year at LS #5 (Trails End) will be installed after LS #23 is online.
- Treatment Plant Blower
 - The new blower is expected in October/November.
- GLASA's Operational Structure
 - Roger Swets contacted Catherine Kaufman (Orangeville's attorney). He said she was supportive and would convey that to the Orangeville Township Board.
- Vista Pt. Sewer Main Damage
 - West Michigan Seawall made another double payment for October.
- MiDeal Pickup Trucks
 - Mr. Knowles informed the Board he ordered two trucks using the MiDeal program.

Financial Statements: September payroll totaled \$45,146.17 and operation expenses (checks #17877-#17898) totaled \$220,929.39. Total September expenses came to \$266,075.56. A motion to pay the September bills was made by Mr. VanVolkinburg and supported by Mr. Rook; the motion passed 3-0.
