

March 2025 Board Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: The March 6th Board Meeting was called to order at 4:06PM by Mr. Leep.

Roll Call: Glenn Leep of Martin, Rob Heethuis of Yankee Springs, Roger VanVolkinburg of Wayland, and Vivian Conner of Orangeville were present. Employees present: Director Larry Knowles, Plant Operator Dave Underwood, and Office Manager Tara Palandri.

Review Minutes: Mr. VanVolkinburg motioned to accept the February Board Meeting minutes as presented. Mr. Heethuis supported the motion; the motion passed 4-0.

Generators

- The generators for LS #33 and LS #26 were received, as well as all of the transfer switches.
- Consumers Energy is working to install the gas at the lift stations.

• Lift Station Pumps

Replacement pumps for LS #33 were ordered.

• SCADA – Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition

Mike Carson has been designing a new SCADA system in his spare time. He has installed
the system at a lift station (#14) and GLASA is now monitoring the system to work out
any bugs. The hope is to be able to have all stations and the plant connected eventually.

• Lawsuit Threat

- Mr. Knowles shared his email conversations with the GLASA attorney.
- o GLASA's insurance company has been notified of the potential lawsuit.
- Mr. Knowles contacted Jones & Henry who is working on a quote.
 - GLASA will only proceed if served.

Financial Statements:
