

June 2025 Board Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: The June 5th Board Meeting was called to order at 4:00PM by Mr. Leep.

Weather

- The large power outage began on the evening of May 15th and power was not completely restored until the 18th. A few of the newest generators ran for over 46 hours.
- Mr. Knowles recapped some of the issues GLASA encountered during and after the storm such as the plant being without internet/phones, a fallen tree on the driveway, and losing function of the potable water well until Monday.

Generators

 Gas was installed at two generator sites and the installation for the two natural gas generators will be scheduled soon. Still waiting on delivery of the LP generator.

Force Main Break

 On May 19th GLASA received a call about a force main break on Barlow Lake Rd. With the help of B&R, the 2" pipe was repaired and the street has been patched. **Financial Statements**: May payroll totaled \$48,547.26 and operation expenses (checks #17307-17331) totaled \$298,891.35. Total May expenses came to \$347,438.61. A motion to pay the May bills as presented was made by Mr. VanVolkinburg and supported by Mr. Heethuis; the motion passed 4-0.
